- to honestly represent American Indian arts and crafts as to nature and origin within the realm of my control
 and offer return privileges for articles found by the Indian Arts and Crafts Association to have been
 misrepresented by me;
- to abide by all federal, state, local and tribal laws pertaining to Indian Arts and Crafts, artifacts and natural resources;
- to abide by ethical business conduct regarding advertising, appraising, pricing and guarantees offered by me;
- to respect and support ethical business activities of all Indian Arts and Crafts Association members;
- to encourage consumer confidence in the authenticity of all articles identified with the IACA seal;
- to cooperate with the law enforcement agencies and the IACA in the investigation of crimes involving Indian arts and crafts and to promote proper identification of Indian arts and crafts.

I have read the IACA Code of Ethics and, with my signature below, agree to adhere to these principles. I understand that membership can be revoked if the Code of Ethics is not adhered to, subject to the action of the IACA Ethics Committee.

- 1. **Retail** \$235/year: Individuals/businesses that are actively engaged in the Indian arts and crafts industry by selling such American Indian art to the ultimate consumer for their personal use.
- 2. Wholesale \$235/year: Individuals/businesses that purchase goods directly from Native American artist/craftspeople for resale to retailers; and/or individuals/businesses who employ Native American artists and craftspeople to produce handmade and handcrafted products for the resale to retailers.
- 3. Wholesale/Retail \$235/year: Individuals/businesses whose operation is both wholesale and retail.
- 4. **Ancillary** \$235/year: Individuals/businesses that either provide supplies or services used in the production of Indian arts or that produce Native made products members might sell in their stores (packaged foods, etc.)
- 5. **Tribal Enterprises, Cooperatives and Guilds** \$235/year: Category open to those organizations which are official tribal enterprises, cooperatives or guilds.
- 6. Subsequent Locations for Retail, Wholesale and Wholesale/Retail members \$70/year: The original IACA membership is the Primary Membership; the membership fee for any additional locations thereafter is \$70.00/each location. (Note: In order to qualify as a Subsequent location, ownership must be the same as that of the Primary location.)

WHAT ARE THE ADVANTAGES OF JOINING IACA?

- 1. The most valuable benefit of membership is identification with an international organization that symbolizes authenticity, quality and integrity in Native American arts and crafts.
- 2. Use of the IACA logo assures buyers, customers and other interested persons that members adhere to the high standards of the industry and that they can purchase authentic Native American handmade arts with confidence.

- 4. Free copy of the IACA Journal published quarterly, which keeps you informed about current events.
